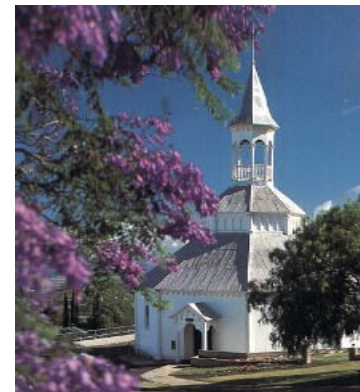

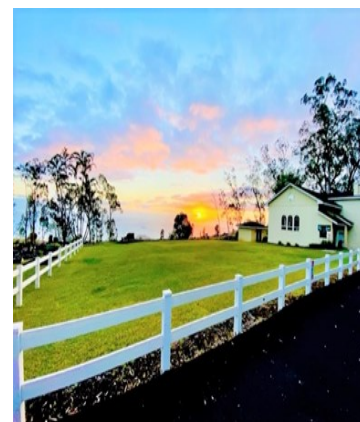

This Sunday's Gospel
Thoughts for the Week

April 7, 2024

We are called to live out God's mercy.

(Reading in Blue Missal pg. 345)



1st Reading Acts 4: 32-35
True Christian Fellowship

This passage depicts the early church of Jerusalem. The emphasis is on being of "one heart and mind". Responsibility for one another was so deeply felt that they shared everything in common. It is a beautiful ideal that is still practiced in the Church's religious societies. It is a way of life that cannot be imposed on all. It must be freely chosen with the firm belief that "my strength and my courage is the Lord, and he has been my savior."

Responsorial Psalm: Give thanks to the Lord for he is good, his love is everlasting.

2nd Reading 1 John 5: 1-6
The Power of Faith

"The victory that conquers the world is our faith." In reading about the enthusiasm of the early Church and recalling the sophisticated way of life and moral decay in the Roman Empire that Christianity gradually overcame, one finds the clue for this accomplishment in John's statement. It is faith. In our day, we see the power of sophistication and moral decay all around us. Seemingly, the Church is losing ground. Why? What about your faith? Is it still a power? Is it still very much alive?

Gospel John 20: 19-31 Living Faith

By relating the well-known tradition of the unbelieving Thomas, the write of John wants to shed further light on the point made in the Second Reading about the importance of faith. He indicates that even seeing, as Thomas did, is no guarantee of faith. Faith comes from hearing the word of the risen Lord who addresses Thomas personally. Christianity knows the golden rule. Faith comes from hearing. It is God, personally addressing you in an "I-Thou" situation! This intangible situation can never be fully explained just as we cannot explain exactly what happens when someone falls in love! Respond when the Lord says: "Shalom-peace" to you in any situation of your life and keep that faith alive!

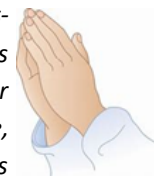

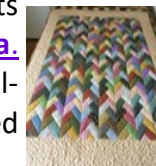
